Care is taken to make the treatment progress slowly enough to make the definitions and the measuring of the physical constants clear. The matter is developed with sufficient rapidity and with enough continuity to give the reader a broad view of the subject as a whole. As a further illustration of the application of the laws of heat, and to give the student a conception of the use to which he should put his study, in Chapters VI, VII, and X, steam power...
